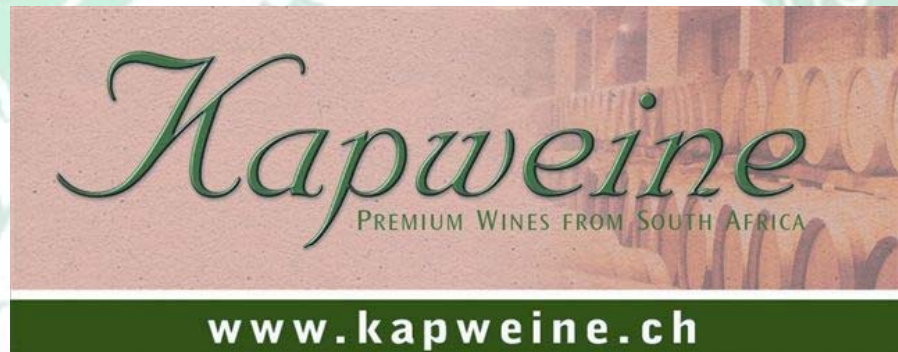


## Reuben's at The Robertson Small Hotel
